To support individuals, young people, organisations and groups within communities to develop new skills and opportunities, whilst building on existing skills, enabling them to reach their true potential through volunteering, community projects and training opportunities.

The main focus of Blackpool Be Involved Volunteering Programme is to improve the ability of young people in Years 9 - 11 from across backgrounds and circumstances, to make informed career decisions, based on their volunteering experiences. Current volunteering project has supported 176 young people into work & moved 565 young people out of experiencing NEET, across the Fylde Coast over the last 4 years. Students will attend one assembly information session and progress to a 4 week 'Move into volunteer' course. Each student will receive:

- One to one meeting to assess individual needs & develop a SMART action plan & skills self-assessment to measure journey travelled
- Access to employers/ businesses for volunteering opportunities. All students who progress to volunteering will be eligible for access to regional national awards, #iwill campaign, access to accredited qualifications and URPotential recognition celebration events.
